Dear Eagle Families,

I hope this letter finds all of you healthy and safe. We are excited to inform you that our campus will be reopening for our Hybrid Model which will allow for students to receive instruction in the classroom for part of the day. While your child's teacher will be reaching out to you with more information regarding your child's schedule, you will want to review the important information below.

Phases of Reopening

Our students will return on the following dates:

Kindergarten & First Grade students will return on November 2nd

Second and Third Grade students will return on November 9th

Fourth and Fifth Grade students will return on November 16th

Families will be notified the Wednesday prior to their child's return to in person learning of the new schedule and class assignment. This means, if you have a child in 2nd-5th grade, information regarding your child's schedule will not be sent to you today.

Schedule

If your child will be returning to the campus, he/she will be assigned to **one** of the following in person sessions.

AM Session 8:10-10:40 a.m.

(Gates open at 7:55 a.m.)

OR

PM Session 12:00-2:30 p.m.

(Gates open at 11:55 a.m.)

If your child will remain on distance learning, you will be receiving more information from the distance learning teacher regarding your child's schedule.

Drop Off/Pick Up

Please remain in your car during drop off/pick up. Students may start arriving 15 minutes before start time and will report directly to class. ***We cannot have students arrive early.***

Meals

Meals will be grab-and-go for both am and pm sessions; students will take meals home at the end of their day. Please make sure your child eats breakfast in the morning as meals will be handed to them as they leave. Please send your child with a water bottle. In addition, we will have meal service for pick-up for our distance learner families daily from 11:15-11:45.

Safety Protocols

- Students will be in classes of no more than 16 students, spread 6 feet apart.
- Students will wash or sanitize hands upon entering classrooms.
- Teachers will walk all students out at dismissal time and keep them socially distanced until parents arrive for pick-up.
- Classrooms will be sanitized using approved products between each group of students.
- Student groups will not mix during their time at school.
- Staff will be on campus all day helping to supervise movement of students.

The safety of our students and staff are my first priority. We are looking forward to seeing our Eagles!
